INTRODUCTION

1. APPLICATION

We set a persistent cookie for statistical purposes. Persistent cookies also enable us to track and target the location and the interests of our users and to enhance the experience of our services on our site.

Some of our business partners use cookies on our site. We have no access to or control over these cookies.
